According to Glenn Carley of Data Bridge Digital, "If a master was recalled for production during our data entry process, we simply entered that master into the OpdiTracker database and within seconds the master was initialized in the system."

Cognos upgraded to OpdiTracker Pro edition, which delivers added security and control, additional search functionality and database reporting, and greater management capabilities.

"The five people in the manufacturing department who have access to the Disc Stakka agree that the new system is very much easier to access and return discs and it is completely secure. And it only takes about ten seconds to search for and eject a disc. The whole process makes the Disc Stakka a very positive experience," said Dave.

Cognos adds up to 40 new discs to the Disc Stakka each month, a task that is handled by members of the manufacturing department, which is responsible for maintaining the software asset register.

"The business benefits of our new software asset management system are greater security and accessibility, time and space savings, traceability and more overall control. It is a much better solution in every way and will provide a return on investment in less than six months."
